



**Year One Curriculum Information  
Autumn Term 2016**

Subject	Children will be learning to:
<p><b>English (Reading, Writing and Speaking and Listening)</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Label objects in and around the classroom.</li> <li>• Write lists and bullet points of family members.</li> <li>• Form each letter of the alphabet correctly.</li> <li>• Read aloud in class ('Where's my teddy').</li> <li>• Follow instructions to make decorations.</li> <li>• Listen to stories from different cultures (Handa's Surprise)</li> <li>• Listen carefully to others.</li> <li>• Take turns when speaking in groups.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Mathematics</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read and write number names to 20</li> <li>• Order and count numbers to 30 reliably.</li> <li>• Count on and back to 10</li> <li>• Find pairs that make; 5,6 and 10</li> <li>• Double numbers from 1 to 5</li> <li>• Recognise 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins.</li> <li>• Recite days of the week and months of the year in order.</li> <li>• Recognise and name solids and shapes.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recognise and describing different materials; wood, metal &amp; plastic</li> <li>• Identify different types of paper; glossy paper, greaseproof paper, writing paper etc.</li> <li>• Identify and name a variety of fabrics</li> <li>• Looking at properties of different materials and fabrics</li> </ul>
<p><b>ICT</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Know how to log on and off a computer</li> <li>• Develop the 'click and drag' skill</li> <li>• Type their names using a keyboard.</li> <li>• Change the size and colour of the font.</li> </ul>
<p><b>History/Geography</b></p> 	<p>In History</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Recognise and discuss how Barking has changed over time</li> <li>• Develop some understand of historical events in the local area</li> </ul> <p>In Geography</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Name and locate the 4 countries of the UK</li> <li>• Identify capital cities of the UK</li> <li>• Describe the local area and it's features</li> </ul>
<p><b>Art/Design and Technology</b></p> 	<p>In Art</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Create a sculpture using a range of materials.</li> </ul> <p>In Design and technology</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Making finger puppets linked to English text</li> </ul>

<b>Physical Education</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• bounce, hop, spring, and jump using a variety of take offs and landings.</li> <li>• to observe, recognise and copy different body shapes.</li> <li>• to link together two or more actions with control and be able to repeat them.</li> <li>• to describe what they see using appropriate vocabulary.</li> </ul>
<b>Music</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use listening skills to recognise a range of sounds.</li> <li>• Add vocal sounds to a song.</li> <li>• Handle classroom instruments with care.</li> </ul>
<b>P.S.H.E</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adapting to new beginnings</li> <li>• Understand what bullying is and how to deal with it appropriately.</li> </ul>
<b>R.E</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Identify the faith groups they belong to and how they make you feel.</li> <li>• Be aware of autumn religious festivals, in particular Christmas as a special occasion for Christians.</li> </ul>

**Things you can do to help at home:**

Hear your child read every night and use the suggested reading activity sheet provided in reading journals..

Play 'eye spy' with sounds.

Regularly count money with them.

Play counting games with objects that they can add together or subtract.
