Year One Curriculum Information Spring Term 2017



Please find information below which details what your child will be learning in school this term. We hope you will find it helpful in supporting your child at home. If you have any queries, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's teacher.

Subject	Children will be learning to:
English (Reading, Writing and Speaking and Listening) kids who succeed	 Write a recount about our trip to Eastbury manor House. Recognise the characters, setting and storyline in a range of traditional tales (The Gingerbread Man, Goldilocks and the Three Bears and The Magic Porridge Pot). Listen carefully to others. Take turns when speaking in groups. Learn weekly spellings and use them in our writing. Use phase 1-4 phonics to build longer, new words.
Mathematics	 Begin to know 2-digit numbers to 100 and locate them on a 100squae grid. Know addition and subtraction facts for numbers up to 20. Use mental addition and subtraction to solve word problems. Recognise and name solids and shapes, and begin to sort them according to their properties. Order days of the week, months of the year. Read the time to o'clock and half hour.
Science	 Identify and label different parts of the body Naming the 5 senses and their uses. Use our senses to explore the environment. Use our senses linked to the English text. Developing our understand of Spring
Computing	 Begin to understand that information is around us in different forms Information comes from a variety of sources Understand that programs respond to a range of inputs.
History	 Learn about homes from the past Trip to Eastbury Manor House Learn about the Sysley family
Art/Design and Technology	In Art To use a range of materials in a drawing. In Design and technology Learn about levers and sliding mechanisms. Make a moving picture with a lever mechanism.
Physical Education	 Ball handling skills - moving a ball in different ways and with different parts of our body
