










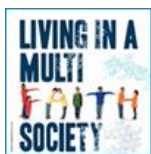
Year One Curriculum Information Summer Term 2017

Subject	Children will be learning to:
Englishy (Reading, Writing and Speaking and Listening) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen carefully to others. • Answer questions about a range of texts • Write weather reports • Retell a personal experience in sequence. • Explore weather poems • Use common words and spell them correctly.
Mathematics 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recognise 2-digit numbers to 100. • Know addition and subtraction facts for numbers up to 50. • Use different coins to make a given amount . Recognise all coins up to £2. • Recognise and name solids and shapes. • Understand symmetry. • Begin to solve simple word problems using pictures and diagrams.
Science 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • About the four seasons • Compare and discuss different garden and wild plants and flowers
Computing 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Represent information graphically, including signs, graphs and pictograms. • Create simple programmes through coding
Geography 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify seasonal weather patterns in the UK • Locate hot and cold countries from around the world • Use a 4 point compass
Art/Design and Technology 	<p>In Art</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Investigate natural and man-made materials <p>In Design and Technology.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prepare fruit and vegetables.
Physical Education 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Play team games and basic athletics.
Music 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use listening skills to recognise a range of sounds. • Change the pitch and volume of vocals in a song. • Handle classroom instruments with care. • Perform a song with movements.
